

Q1 What parks or facilities have you visited/used in Logansport during the past 12 months? Please select all that apply.









Q4 Has any member of your household participated in any recreation programs/events offered by Logansport Parks and Recreation during the past two years?






Q6 How would you rate the overall quality of recreation programs/events offered by Logansport Parks and Recreation in which your household has participated?







Q16 What is your gender?



Q17 How many years have you lived in Logansport?


